for the renewal of a club licence

**DECISION OF THE MANAWATU DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE (ON THE PAPERS)**

This application was considered by the Manawatu District Licensing Committee pursuant to the provisions of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

**Application**

FEILDING OLD BOYS OROUA RUGBY AND NETBALL CLUB INCORPORATED has applied for the renewal of a club licence in respect of premises situated at 45 Nelson Street, Feilding, and known as FOB Oroua Clubrooms.

**Inquiring Agency Reports**

***Police***

The New Zealand Police do not oppose the application.

***Licensing Inspector***

A report from the Manawatu District Council Licensing Inspector dated 20 April 2023 was received and considered. The Inspector did not oppose the application.

***Medical Officer of Health***

The Medical Officer of Health does not oppose the application.

**Local Alcohol Policy**

There is no local alcohol policy in force within the Manawatu district.

**Consideration of the application**

As no objection to the application has been filed and no matters of opposition have been raised by the inquiring agencies, the application was considered on the papers.

In considering whether to renew the club licence, the licensing committee considered the criteria set out in section 131 of the Act.

**District Licensing Committee decision**

*Having regard to the information supporting the application and having regard to the criteria set out in section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 the Manawatu District Licensing Committee grants the renewal of a club licence to FEILDING OLD BOYS OROUA RUGBY AND NETBALL CLUB INCORPORATED in respect of premises situated at 45 Nelson Street, Feilding, and known as FOB Oroua Clubrooms, for a period of three years expiring on the 31st day of March 2026, subject to the following conditions:*

1. Alcohol must be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:



**Sunday to Thursday**

**4.00 p.m. to 9.00 p.m.**

**Friday, Saturday & Public Holidays**

**12.00 p.m. to 12.00 a.m.**

2. The club must have a secretary at all times.
3. Within 10 working days of the appointment of a new secretary, the club must inform the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee of the name of the new secretary.
4. All proceeds from the sale of alcohol shall belong to the club.
5. The club must ensure that, while the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, no person consumes on the premises, any alcohol not sold or supply on the premises by the club.
6. The club must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the club is open for the sale of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments and low-alcohol beverages.
7. Water must be freely available at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol as follows:  
Water located at the bar counter
8. Food must be available for consumption on the premises as follows:  
A range of food choices must be always readily available. Menus must be visible, and food must be actively promoted. A minimum of three (3) types of food should be available. The range or style of food will be as shown on any menu submitted.
9. The club must ensure that signs are prominently displayed within the licensed premises detailing information regarding alternative forms of transport from the premises.
10. The club must implement and maintain the steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol.
11. The club must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed.
