District Licensing Committee decision

*Having regard to the information supporting the application and having regard to the criteria set out in section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 the Manawatu District Licensing Committee grants the renewal of an on-licence to **BROOKFIELD PARTNERSHIP LIMITED** in respect of premises situated at 15 Stanway Road, Halcombe and known as Halcombe Tavern for a period of three years expiring on the 28th April 2029, subject to the following conditions:*

1. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 8.00 a.m. to 2.00 a.m. the following day
2. The following steps must be taken to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol:
The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments and low-alcohol beverages.
3. The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
4. The licensee must ensure that signs are prominently displayed within the licensed premises detailing information regarding alternative forms of transport from the premises.
5. The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol.
6. Food must be available for consumption on the premises as follows:
A range of food choices must be readily available at all times that the premises are open. Menus must be visible and food should be actively promoted. A minimum of three (3) types of food should be available. The range or style of food will be as shown on any menu submitted. Alternatively, the range of food should include such items as paninis, pizzas, lasagna, toasted or fresh sandwiches, wedges, pies, filled rolls, and/or salads
7. Each of the following parts of the premises is designated as:
Supervised Area Every Bar
8. Drink water must be freely available to customers while the premises are open for business from the bar.
9. A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from Stanway Road is designated as principal entrance.
