DECISION OF THE MANAWATU DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE (ON THE PAPERS)

This application was considered by the Commissioner of the Manawatu District Licensing Committee pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Application

FEILDING GOLF CLUB INCORPORATED has applied for the renewal of a club licence in respect of premises situated at 1487 Waughs Road, Feilding and known as Feilding Golf Club.

Inquiring Agency Reports

Police

The New Zealand Police do not oppose the application.

Licensing Inspector

A report from the Manawatu District Council Licensing Inspector dated 11 June 2025 was received and considered. The Inspector did not oppose the application.

Medical Officer of Health

The Medical Officer of Health does not oppose the application.

Local Alcohol Policy

There is no local alcohol policy in force within the Manawatu district.

Consideration of the application

As no objection to the application has been filed and no matters of opposition have been raised by the inquiring agencies, the application was considered pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 by the Commissioner of the District Licensing Committee sitting alone.

In considering whether to renew the club licence, the licensing committee considered the criteria set out in section 131 of the Act.

District Licensing Committee decision

Having regard to the information supporting the application and having regard to the criteria set out in section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 the Manawatu District Licensing Committee grants the renewal of a club licence to **FEILDING GOLF CLUB INCORPORATED** in respect of premises situated at 1487 Waughs Road, Feilding and known as Feilding Golf Club for a period of three years expiring on the 5th day of April 2028, subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol must be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Thursday

p.m. during periods of daylight saving)

Friday to Sunday and Public Holidays

10.30 a.m. to 10.00 p.m. (extended to 11.00 p.m. during periods of daylight saving)

10.30 a.m. to 12.00 midnight

- 2. The club shall have a secretary at all times.
- 3. Within 10 working days of the appointment of a new secretary, the secretary of the appropriate licensing committee is told the name of the new secretary.
- 4. All proceeds from the sale of alcohol belong to the club.
- 5. The Club Committee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed.
- 6. Drinking water must be freely available and this must be clear to customers, while the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
- 7. Food must be available for consumption on the premises as follows:

 At all times when the premises are authorised to be open for the sale of alcohol, a minimum of three (3) types of food should be available consisting of a range and style similar to that shown on any menu submitted or a range of snack foods in the nature of pies, sandwiches, filled rolls, pizzas and the like. Food must be conveniently available for all members and their guests, and the availability of those foodstuffs must be notified to them by appropriate notices throughout the premises.
- 8. A range of low-alcohol and non-alcoholic drinks must be available at all times when the premises are open for the sale of alcohol.
- 9. The licensee must ensure that signs are prominently displayed within the licensed premises detailing information regarding alternative forms of transport from the premises.
- 10. There must be no BYO alcohol on the premises while alcohol is available for sale.
- 11. A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from Waugh Road is designated as the principal entrance.
