IN THE MATTER	of an application by FEILDING TENNIS CLUB INCORPORATED for the renewal of an club licence

DECISION OF THE MANAWATU DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE (ON THE PAPERS)

This application was considered by the Commissioner of the Manawatu District Licensing Committee pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Application

FEILDING TENNIS CLUB INCORPORATED has applied for the renewal of an club licence in respect of premises situated at 151 South Street, Feilding and known as Feilding Tennis Club.

Inquiring Agency Reports

Police

The New Zealand Police do not oppose the application.

Licensing Inspector

A report from the Manawatu District Council Licensing Inspector dated 3 December 2025 was received and considered. The Inspector did not oppose the application.

Medical Officer of Health

The Medical Officer of Health does not oppose the application.

Local Alcohol Policy

There is no local alcohol policy in force within the Manawatu district.

Consideration of the application

As no objection to the application has been filed and no matters of opposition have been raised by the inquiring agencies, the application was considered pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 by the Commissioner of the District Licensing Committee sitting alone.

In considering whether to renew the club licence, the licensing committee considered the criteria set out in section 131 of the Act.

District Licensing Committee decision

*Having regard to the information supporting the application and having regard to the criteria set out in section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 the Manawatu District Licensing Committee grants the renewal of an club licence to **FEILDING TENNIS CLUB INCORPORATED** in respect of premises situated at 151 South Street, Feilding and known as Feilding Tennis Club for a period of three years expiring on the 21st November 2028, subject to the following conditions:*

1. Alcohol must be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Friday – 5.30 p.m. to 11.00 p.m.
Saturday and Sunday – 2.00 p.m. to 11.00 p.m.
2. The club must have a secretary at all times and within 10 working days of the appointment of a new secretary, the club must inform the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee of the name of the new secretary.
3. All proceeds from the sale of alcohol belong to the club.
4. The club must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the club is open for the sale of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol refreshments.
5. Drinking water must be freely available and this must be clear to customers, while the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
6. Food must be available for sale and consumption on the premises, in portions suitable for a single customer at reasonable prices and within a reasonable time of being ordered as follows:
A range of food choices must be readily available at all times. Menus must be visible and food should be actively promoted. A minimum of three (3) types of food should be available. The range or style of food will be as shown on any menu submitted.
7. A telephone must be freely available for customers to call for transport and staff must assist if required. Telephone numbers for alternative forms of transport from the premises must be displayed.
8. A Host Responsibility Policy must be maintained and displayed at all points of sale and the Licensee must ensure all staff receive training in their responsibilities and obligations under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
9. There must be no sale or supply of alcohol to minors or intoxicated persons and there must be displayed at every point-of-sale appropriate signs detailing these restrictions.
10. The area where alcohol is to be sold and consumed is described in the plan date stamped as received by the District Licensing Committee on 1 November 2022 and no alcohol is to be taken out of this area.
11. A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from South Street is designated as the principal entrance.
