DECISION OF THE MANAWATU DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE (ON THE PAPERS)

This application was considered by the Commissioner of the Manawatu District Licensing Committee pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Application

1ZERO2 LIMITED has applied for a special licence to provide alcohol sales. The application is for an exhibitor stand at the 2026 Feilding Craft Market and the Feilding Equine Expo.

Inquiring Agency Reports

Police

The New Zealand Police do not oppose the application.

Licensing Inspector

A report from the Manawatu District Council Licensing Inspector dated 23 April 2026 was received and considered. The Inspector does not oppose the application.

Medical Officer of Health

The Medical Officer of Health does not oppose the application.

Local Alcohol Policy

There is no local alcohol policy in force within the Manawatu district.

Consideration of the application

As no objection to the application has been filed and no matters of opposition have been raised by the inquiring agencies, the application was considered pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 by the Chairperson of the District Licensing Committee sitting alone.

In considering whether to issue a special licence, the licensing committee considered the criteria set out in section 142 of the Act.

District Licensing Committee decision

*Having regard to the information supporting the application and having regard to the criteria set out in section 142 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 the Manawatu District Licensing Committee grants the issue of a special licence to **1ZERO2 LIMITED** in respect of the events for which the licence was sought, subject to the following conditions:*

1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
Saturday, 16 May 2026: 10.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m. – Equine Expo
Friday, 5 June 2026: 8.30 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. – Feilding Craft Market
Saturday, 6 June 2026: 8.30 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. – Feilding Craft Market
Friday, 9 October 2026: 8.30 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. – Feilding Craft Market
Saturday, 10 October 2026: 8.30 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. – Feilding Craft Market
2. The licensee must display a copy of this special licence at the point of sale so as to be easily read by people attending the event.
3. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale or supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
“Alcohol will not be served to minors”, “No Id, No Service, No Exception” and “Alcohol will not be served to anyone intoxicated” signs must be displayed.
4. Drinking water must be freely available at the exhibitor’s site while it is open for business.
5. The volume of individual free sample tastings must not exceed 5ml.
6. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed.

Duration

This licence is in force from 10.00 a.m. Saturday 16 May 2026 to 4.00 p.m. Saturday 10 October 2026 during the days and hours detailed in condition (1) above.
