

SPECIAL LICENCE

Sections 22, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, Anglican Parish Of The Oroua is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at St Johns Anglican Church Hall, 13 Camden Street, Feilding, to any person attending the following occasion or event (*or* series of occasions or events):

COMMUNITY BALL WITH DANCING, LIVE BAND AND SUPPER

The Committee grants an exemption pursuant to section 213(2) of the Act in respect of the appointment of a manager for the duration of the Special Licence.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following day and during the following hours:

 Saturday. 19 July 2025

 6.30 p.m. to 10.30 p.m.
- Saturday, 19 July 2025
 6.30 p.m. to 10.30 p.m.

 The licensee must display a copy of this special licence at the point of sale to be easily read by people attending the event.
- 3. The Church Hall must be designated as Supervised.
- 4. The persons nominated to manage the sale and supply of alcohol at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol is Nigel Jourdan and a sign shall be prominently displayed at the point of sale, which identifies by name the person responsible under the licence.
- 5. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale or supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - Signage at the counter, staff to check ID, staff to monitor for minors and intoxicated persons, minors will not be served alcohol, intoxicated persons will not be served alcohol
- 6. Drinking water must be freely available at the following places while the premises are open for business: **On all tables and must be refilled during the event.**
- 7. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times alcohol is available for sale or supply as follows or similar:
 - As per the attached Menu attached.
- 8. Low-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises as follows:
- One type of light beer must be provided.
- 9. Non-alcoholic beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises including but not limited to fruit juice and ginger beer.
- 10. A telephone must be freely available for customers to call for transport and staff must assist if required. Telephone numbers for alternative forms of transport from the premises must be displayed.

Duration

This licence is in force from 6.30 p.m. to 10.30 p.m. Saturday, 19 July 2025.
