DECISION OF THE MANAWATU DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE (ON THE PAPERS)

This application was considered by the Manawatu District Licensing Committee pursuant to the provisions of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Application

CATALYST FRUIT WINES has applied for a special licence to provide alcohol sales. The application relates to the Friday markets held in Feilding Town Square between 4 September 2026 and 25 June 2027.

Inquiring Agency Reports

Police

The New Zealand Police do not oppose the application.

Licensing Inspector

A report from the Manawatu District Council Licensing Inspector dated 30 July 2026 was received and considered. The Inspector does not oppose the application.

Medical Officer of Health

The Medical Officer of Health does not oppose the application.

Local Alcohol Policy

There is no local alcohol policy in force within the Manawatu district.

Consideration of the application

As no objection to the application has been filed and no matters of opposition have been raised by the inquiring agencies, the application was considered on the papers.

In considering whether to issue a special licence, the licensing committee considered the criteria set out in section 142 of the Act.

District Licensing Committee decision

*Having regard to the information supporting the application and having regard to the criteria set out in section 142 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 the Manawatu District Licensing Committee grants the issue of a special licence to **CATALYST FRUIT WINES** in respect of the event for which the licence was sought, subject to the following conditions:*

1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:

4 September 2026	8.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.
2 October 2026	8.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.
9 October 2026	8.30 a.m. to 3.00 p.m.
6 November 2026	8.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.
4 December 2026	8.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.
18 December 2026	8.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.
5 February 2027	8.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.
5 March 2027	8.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.
2 April 2027	8.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.
7 May 2027	8.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.
4 June 2027	8.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.
25 June 2027	8.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.

2. The licensee must display a copy of this special licence at the point of sale so as to be easily read by people attending the event.
3. A certificated manager must be on duty within the licensed area at all times when alcohol is being sold or supplied. The manager's full name must be prominently displayed.
4. Drinking water must be freely available from the exhibitor's site while it is open for business.
5. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale or supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
Signage at the counter, staff to check ID, minors and intoxicated persons will not be sold alcohol
6. Samples are to be served in no larger than 10ml glass tumblers
