DECISION OF THE MANAWATU DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE (ON THE PAPERS)

This application was considered by the Commissioner of the Manawatu District Licensing Committee pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Application

Julia Moretti, on behalf of Hiwinui Country Estate has applied for a special licence to provide alcohol sales. The application relates to two Christmas function events.

Inquiring Agency Reports

Police

The New Zealand Police do not oppose the application.

Licensing Inspector

A report from the Manawatu District Council Licensing Inspector dated **15 September 2025** was received and considered. The Inspector does not oppose the application.

Medical Officer of Health

The Medical Officer of Health does not oppose the application.

Local Alcohol Policy

There is no local alcohol policy in force within the Manawatu district.

Consideration of the application

As no objection to the application has been filed and no matters of opposition have been raised by the inquiring agencies, the application was considered pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 by the Chairperson of the District Licensing Committee sitting alone.

In considering whether to issue a special licence, the licensing committee considered the criteria set out in section 142 of the Act.

District Licensing Committee decision

Having regard to the information supporting the application and having regard to the criteria set out in section 142 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 the Manawatu District Licensing Committee grants the issue of a special licence to Hiwinui Country Estate (2003) Limited in respect of the events for which the licence was sought, subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following day and during the following hours:

Sunday, 30 November 2025 11.30 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. Christmas Lunch Thursday, 11 December 2025 5.30 p.m. to 10.00 p.m. Christmas Dinner

- 2. The licensee must display a copy of this special licence at the point of sale so as to be easily read by people attending the event
- 3. The persons nominated to manage the sale and supply of alcohol at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol are Julia Moretti and Gian Moretti. A sign shall be prominently displayed at the point of sale, which identifies by name the person responsible under the licence
- The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale or supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 Signage at the counter, staff to check ID, staff to monitor for minors and intoxicated
- 5. Drinking water must be freely available at the bar and all tables and must be refilled during the event.

persons, minors will not be served alcohol, intoxicated persons will not be served alcohol.

- 6. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times alcohol is available for sale or supply as follows or similar: Canapés followed by three course set meal.
- 7. Low-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises including but not limited to Fugazi Sessions.
- 8. Non-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises including but not limited to soft drinks, % beer and juice.
- A telephone must be freely available for customers to call for transport and staff must assist
 if required. Telephone numbers for alternative forms of transport from the premises must
 be displayed.

Duration

This licence is in force from 11.30a.m., 30 November 2025 until 10.00.p.m., 11 December 2025 as detailed in condition 1 above.
