DECISION OF THE MANAWATU DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE (ON THE PAPERS)

This application was considered by the Commissioner of the Manawatu District Licensing Committee pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Application

TANGIMOANA BOATING CLUB INCORPORATED has applied for a special licence to provide alcohol sales. The application relates to twelve different Fishing Competitions.

Inquiring Agency Reports

Police

The New Zealand Police do not oppose the application.

Licensing Inspector

A report from the Manawatu District Council Licensing Inspector dated 8 December 2025 was received and considered. The Inspector does not oppose the application.

Medical Officer of Health

The Medical Officer of Health does not oppose the application.

Local Alcohol Policy

There is no local alcohol policy in force within the Manawatu district.

Consideration of the application

As no objection to the application has been filed and no matters of opposition have been raised by the inquiring agencies, the application was considered pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 by the Chairperson of the District Licensing Committee sitting alone.

In considering whether to issue a special licence, the licensing committee considered the criteria set out in section 142 of the Act.

District Licensing Committee decision

*Having regard to the information supporting the application and having regard to the criteria set out in section 142 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 the Manawatu District Licensing Committee grants the issue of a special licence to **TANGIMOANA BOATING CLUB INCORPORATED** in respect of the events for which the licence was sought, subject to the following conditions:*

1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following day and during the following hours:
Wednesday, 31 December 2025 7.00 p.m. to 12.30 a.m. Band for new year's eve and supper
Friday, 16 January 2026 5.00 p.m. to 12.00 a.m. Registration and briefing – boat comp
Saturday, 17 January 2026 5.00 p.m. to 12.00 a.m. Boat fishing competition
Sunday, 18 January 2026 5.00 p.m. to 12.00 a.m. Boat fishing competition prize giving
Saturday, 24 January 2026 1.00 p.m. to 5.00 p.m. Kids herring hunt comp/prize giving
Friday, 13 February 2026 4.00 p.m. to 11.00 p.m. Surf casting comp registration
Saturday, 14 February 2026 4.00 p.m. to 11.00 p.m. Surf casting comp prize giving
Saturday, 14 March 2026 4.00 p.m. to 11.00 p.m. Ladies fishing competition
Sunday, 15 March 2026 4.00 p.m. to 11.00 p.m. Ladies fishing competition
Friday, 20 March 2026 5.00 p.m. to 12.00 a.m. Hi-5 fishing competition registration
Saturday, 21 March 2026 5.00 p.m. to 12.00 a.m. Hi-5 fishing competition prize giving
Sunday, 29 March 2026 4.00 p.m. to 11.00 p.m. Tuna comp prize giving
2. The licensee must display a copy of this special licence at the point of sale as to be easily read by people attending the event.
3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed.
4. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale or supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
Signage at the counter, staff to check ID, staff to monitor for minors and intoxicated persons, minors will not be served alcohol, intoxicated persons will not be served alcohol.
5. Drinking water must be freely available from the bar while the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
6. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times alcohol is available for sale as detailed in the application or similar.
7. Low-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises including but not limited to Heineken Lite, Export 2% and Amstel light.
8. Non-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises including but not limited to tea, coffee, soft drinks and juice.
9. A telephone must be freely available for customers to call for transport and staff must assist if required. Telephone numbers for alternative forms of transport from the premises must be displayed.

This licence is in force from Wednesday **31 December 2025 7.00 p.m. to 11.00 p.m. Sunday 29 March 2026.**
