4.5 Other General Business

- **Andrew Hansen** – We welcomed Andrew to our meeting to talk about Security and security cameras in the village. There have been a few incidents in the village over the past couple of months. We wanted to be advised as to how to combat these. Andrew explained that cameras may not be the best solution as there are quite a few issues – cost, privacy & monitoring. The more effective crime prevention is through lighting, signage and neighbourhood support. We agreed that securing items to the best of our abilities to prevent theft in the first place was the best option, but if someone is determined to steal something, they will find a way.
- **Sharing Shelves** – Signs have been completed.
- **MDC Community Funds:** Balance of 2025/26 funds have now been clarified. We now agree that there is \$0.00 remaining. The 2026/2027 Project funds need to be applied for by 30 June. Jeannette to submit. There is also a contested Planning Fund of \$60,000 for larger projects.
- **Calendar of Community Events 2026/2027** – Agreed to start a Calendar of Events.
- **Mural** – A process must be followed before proceeding.
- **Teapot for the Hall** – unanimously agreed to purchase after research completed.
- **Vested Assets Policy** – discussed that any project that involves MDC taking over control, must be approved by MDC first.
- **Halcombe Hall** – MDC requires us to submit an annual report (Maureen does this monthly) and a financial report (this is done monthly through our financial statements to MDC). As Maureen does the day-to-day running and bookings of the hall, she gave us a verbal report on what this involves. She also has a Hall Team of Richard Bain, Vicki Powell and Kathy Smith.
