4.5 Other General Business

- We welcomed Colin McFadzean, Independent Chair of the New Business Unit for Flood Resilience, to our meeting to give us an update on progress. A working committee has been set up between MDC and Horizons. Part 1 - to create 3 retention ponds in Halcombe area, construction is planned for Oct 2026. Part 2 - working with Horizons on clearing of Rangitawa stream and open drains in the Halcombe area.
Stormwater pipes along Mt Biggs/Halcombe Road to connect to Feilding ongoing 2026/27.
- We also welcomed Mayor Michael to our meeting. He informed us of the tsunami of changes from Central Gov't that MDC needs to deal with. The big 3 are 'Local Water Done Well', Urban development (Classes 1,2 & 3 soils), Earthquake prone buildings
- Sharing Shelves – Nick Beauchamp has redone 1 of the signs for the shelves. Jeannette to chase up Perspex for the shelf doors.
- MDC Community Funds – discussed reallocation of funds. All Spending needs to be locked in by end April.
- Community Committees Forum – 5 of us attended this forum. Informative and good idea sharing with other committees.
