2.1	Finances	Community Planning and Implementation Funding: \$7800 carried over from 2024/25 \$10,000 for 2025/26. Community Committee Project Funding: \$7126 carried over from 2024/25 for the sunset viewing Platform. Application has been approved for \$3,000 funding for: Waitangi Day Picnic in the Park, Basketball Court to be resealed, painted and a new hoop installed. \$2332.56 is the amount MDC has recorded as awaiting approval for carryover for sunset viewing platform.
