Council Update September 2024 – Rongotea

In September meetings, Council heard from Millie Evans and Luca Giordani, who received representative grants to compete in national and international sports events.

Council heard from a ratepayer in public forum about rates charges and unnecessary expenditure. The Mayor has responded in writing regarding the concerns raised. (Public Forum can be viewed near the beginning of the video recording for 5 September 2024 meeting on MDC website).

Council adopted the new Marae and Hapu Committees Policy, which provides Marae and Hapu Committees with funding similar to that provided to Community Committees. (*The policy can be viewed in the agenda for 19 September 2024*, *beginning on page 31*).
