MDC update.

Cr Alison gave a brief update on things happening over summer. Its roadworks season with much resealing planned throughout the district. If you feel the roadside grass is getting too long, please report it through Antenno.

Local Water Done Well. The government needs to know each council's preferred option shortly. MDC putting it to the vote this Thurs but its looking like MDC will stay "stand alone".

Consultation still open on Development Contributions policy (Feb 14th 2025). Council working through 2025/26 draft annual plan. Keeping it business as usual this year. No new projects.

From Helen, MDC Community Development Advisor. Discussed Grant Guru for those looking to apply for third party funding; Annual community committee funding of \$3000. It was agreed that repairs to the exterior of the hall should be the main focus; Lots of holiday programmes being provided over the summer school holidays at both the Makino Pool and Manawatū Community Hub Library – all welcome.

General business:

1. Tangimoana Boat Ramp Inc update – Sam Veale. We are now official with NZ Charities and the bank. The committee are Sam Veale, Heather McDonald, Kieran Grice. They are going to put a sign at the boat ramp saying this is a community facility and will provide bank a/c details so that people can make donations for using it. Would the committee consider giving a donation or sponsorship? They would get acknowledgement.
2. Parking at playground. Jennifer and Annie met with James from MDC Parks & Property to discuss two potential sites. James getting quotes.
3. Beach Entrance. MDCs roading contractor had cleared this for summer last week. Looking good. Let's hope there's not too many westerly winds over summer. Still some concern about signage on where to park. Lets see how it goes over summer.
4. Greenwaste Fence. A second quote is being sort by MDC as the first one was quite expensive.
5. Bulk waste collection. Apologies from Smart Environmental for the mix up with the date. It will now be this Saturday the 21st December. Will be well advertised.
6. Scotts Ferry Rd. Helen from MDC will ask the roading dept. if it would be a suitable site for their dust suppressant.
7. Monument on stock bank in Aru St. Historic site. Needs spraying around and kept tidy. Helen from MDC will see if Green By Nature can add it to their schedule.
8. Hall hire by Tangimoana School. Principal Trudy asked if they could have one annual charge and be invoiced.
That Tangimoana School be charged \$150.00 for the years hall hire.
