Here's my report:

- Its is local government election year. Mayor Helen has announced that after 9 years in the role, she will be stepping down.
- If anyone is interested in standing for MDC there is lots of information on the MDC Website.
   Nominations open 4<sup>th</sup> July and close on 1<sup>st</sup> August. There will be an information evening held for anyone keen to find out more. MDC requires 5 Rural Ward councillors, 5 Feilding Ward councillors, one Māori Ward councillor and of course a mayor. If elected, the role will commence in late October and will be for a three year period.
- Local Water Done Well. MDCs preferred option of a stand alone in-house model has now been formally adopted. We received 505 submissions from the public and 96% supported this model. The next step is to present the government (Dept. Internal Affairs) with our Water Services Delivery plan by early September.
- Community Honours 2025 is now open for nominations. If you or an organisation would like to nominate someone for services to the community the nomination form and criteria are on the front page of the MDC website.
- Freedom Camping bylaw.

We had a couple of submissions from national bodies like the NZMCA who felt MDC's proposals around Tangimoana were too restrictive. Please email any feedback to me on the following:
