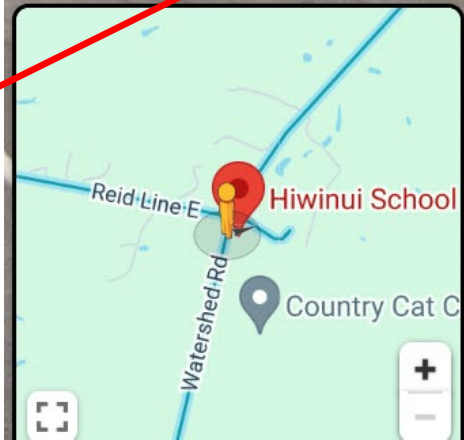
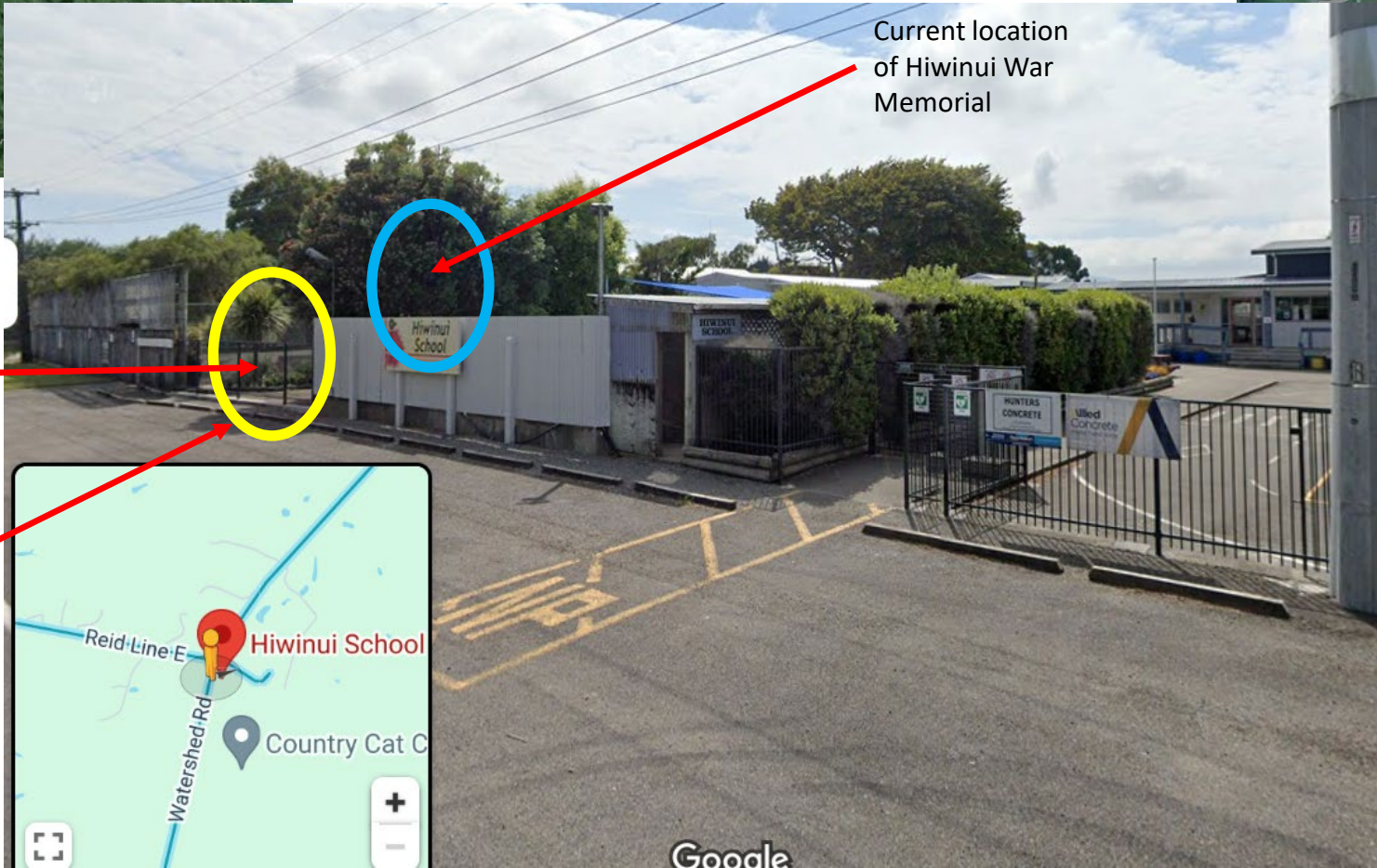
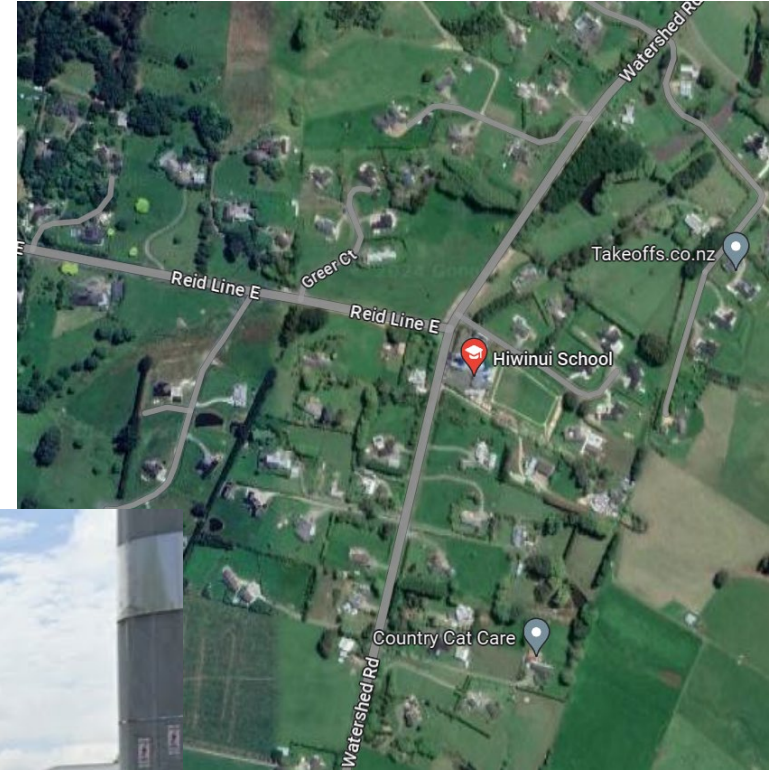


Hiwinui War Memorial (constructed 1919):

“For King and Country, For Freedom and Justice. All Honour give to those who nobly striving nobly fell that we might live. Erected in Honour of the Boys who attended the Hiwinui School and who Served in the Great War 1914-1919.”

Additional names were added to it after WWII.



Initial intent of the Hiwinui War Memorial:

“A memorial and roll of honour to perpetuate the services and sacrifices of all those boys who at any time attended Hiwinui school, and who served in the Great War.”

Hiwinui War Memorial:

WWI:

- 28 soldiers from Hiwinui departed;
- 7 were killed;
- 15 wounded

WWII:

- 19 soldiers from Hiwinui departed;
- 4 were killed
