## **1.Introduction.**

### **1.1 Brief:**

Robinson Tree Services have been requested to inspect the protected English Oak (*Quercus robur*) situated at 19 Pharazyn St, Feilding. The inspection is to ascertain the likelihood of failure, which is of concern to the residents of 1 Florence Pl, Feilding

## **2. Site visit and Observations**

### **2.1 Site visit.**

I carried out a climbing inspection and visual tree assessment of the tree on 8 November, 2023. I took 16 photographs of the root plate, trunk, lateral branches and canopy, which are contained in a separate attachment.

### **2.2 Observations**

Root plate and surrounds: No disturbance or lifting

Trunk: No visual defects

Main scaffold or lateral branches: No visual defects

Crown/canopy: Minor deadwood (less than 50mm in diameter) present. Normal sized leaves, with even distribution throughout canopy.

## **3.Recommendations**

### **3.1**

<b>Action</b>	<b>Outcome</b>
Removal of deadwood.	Prevent deadwood from falling onto property of 1 Florence Pl, alleviating residents concerns.
Light reduction of canopy extending over goldfish pond and garden.	Provide separation between house on 1 Florence Pl and canopy of tree, creating space and lessening overbearing presence of tree.

## **4.Conclusions**

The tree presents with no obvious defects. There is no evidence to suggest failure of root plate, trunk or branches is likely in normal climatic conditions.
