Kia ora Andrew,

In the preceding year, the Manawātū District Council Concession (WA-219) was suspended at Pukepuke Lagoon Conservation Area (see attached letter). The concession remains suspended.

The rationale behind the suspension was the discernible non-compliance with the contractual provisions pertaining to environmental monitoring and reporting. Consequently, in order to facilitate the potential lifting of the suspension, a formal request was made for the submission of an environmental plan, designed to rectify the aforementioned breaches and fulfill the prescribed conditions.

Regrettably, thus far, no environmental plan has been received, impeding any progress towards the restoration of the concession's operational status.

Can you please provide an update of how this plan/programme is developing? I'm aware David Flintoff had made progression, however he is no longer with the council.
