As part of our concession with the Department of Conservation the Oroua Drainage board can mechanically remove vegetation within the easement area that covers the inlet, outlet and perimeter drain (identified by the yellow lines) in order to maintain capacity. Before we complete any mechanical clearance, we are keen to have an ecological assessment completed to identify the following (limited to the easement area).

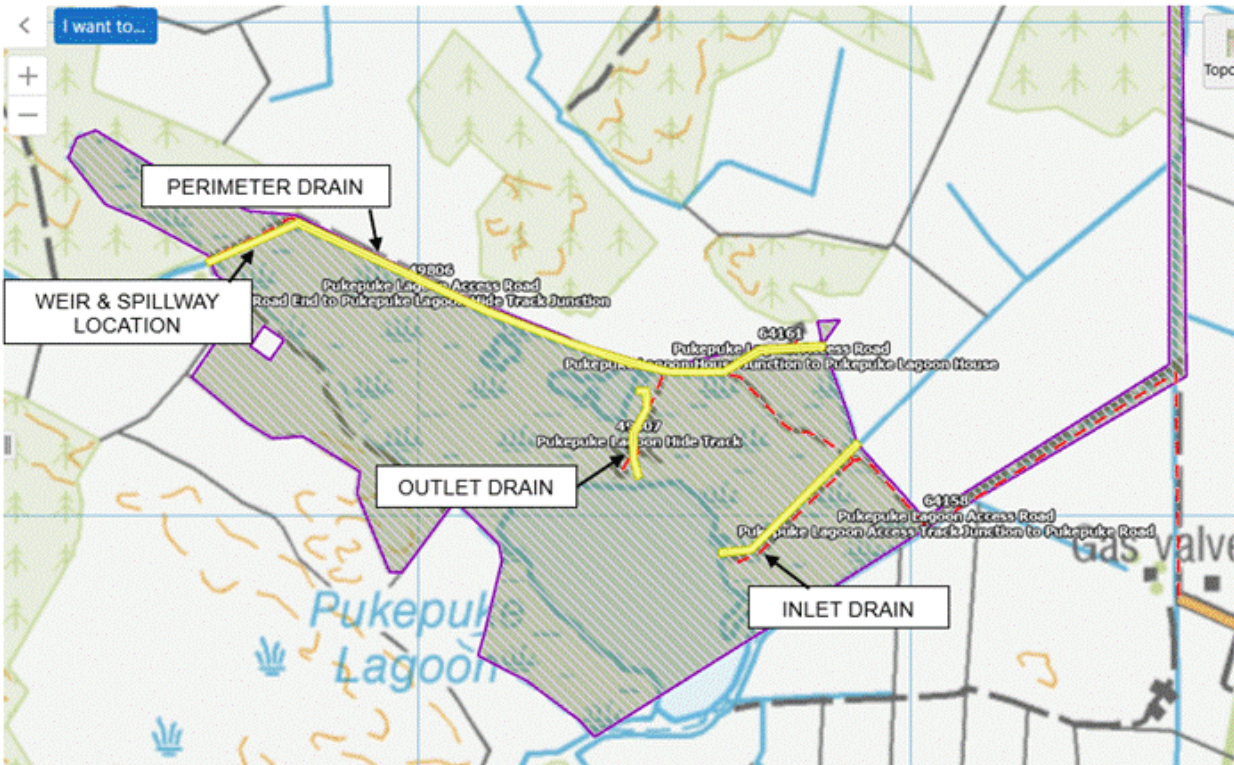
- Invasive weeds
- Note any pest aquatic fish (Carp)
- A general description of the vegetation within the easement
- recommendations around the use of spray to control invasive plants if applicable.

The easement area is

- Inlet approximately 3,700m²
- Outlet approximately 3,500m²
- Perimeter channel 17,200m²

We are keen to get this work done prior to 15 April 2025 so we have time to do the mechanical clearance before the end of April.

Could you please indicate if Rec services can incorporate this work into their schedule and if so is it possible to provide an indication of the potential costs.
