This permit authorises the permittee to enter Pukepuke Conservation Area subject to the Conditions printed on this permit and all relevant Acts and Regulations.

This permit is not valid unless signed by the permittee and must be carried while visiting Pukepuke Conservation Area and produced on demand.

This permit does not entitle the holder to hunt game birds unless a licence issued under the Wildlife Act 1953 is also held.

### CONDITIONS

- 1 Powerboats are not permitted in Pukepuke Lagoon
- 2 Fishing is not permitted in Pukepuke Conservation Area
- 3 This permit allows for access to Pukepuke Conservation Area only. It does not entitle the holder to hunt in or take dogs into Pukepuke Conservation Area
- 4 Game-bird hunting is permitted only during gamebird season. People using firearms or dogs for game-bird hunting must have a valid permit from Fish & Game.
- 5 This permit is not transferable and must be produced on demand to any warranted officer or any other authorised person, and may at any time be cancelled by public notice issued by radio or published in a newspaper of the district.
- 6 This permit confers no right to cut, fell or remove any trees, shrubs, or other forest produce.
- 7 Care must be taken to remove all litter and ensure that streams, rivers and lakes are not polluted.
- 8 This permit does not entitle the holder to enter any area under licence, lease or permit, nor does it confer a right of access except by way of defined legal roads or rights of way. Permission to cross any private land must be obtained from the owner.
- 9 In consideration of being given permission to enter on Conservation land, the permit holders agree that they do so entirely at their own risk.
- 10 Subject to special requirements and the written permission of the Director Operations, variations to these conditions may be permitted.
